4.5 million Ghanaians are “moderately or severely food insecure”




Food insecurity exists in every region of Ghana especially urban areas

- Operators of West Africa's first and largest food bank in Ghana since 2015
 - Have a nationwide network of 245 vetted community based beneficiaries & organization
 - Recovers 13 tons of perfectly edible food monthly and redistribute to 5435+ beneficiaries and beneficiary organizations

- Provides vocational training and employment recommendation for unskilled youths
 - Recognized by the Global FoodBanking Network and global reputable organizations

If food waste could be reduced by just 25%, hunger and poverty could be eliminated

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- 2019 amount of food recovered and distributed = **GHs685,000**
- 2020 operational budget = **GHs2,420,803 (\$419,691)**
- 2020 YTD percentage of Food donated in kind = **53%**




